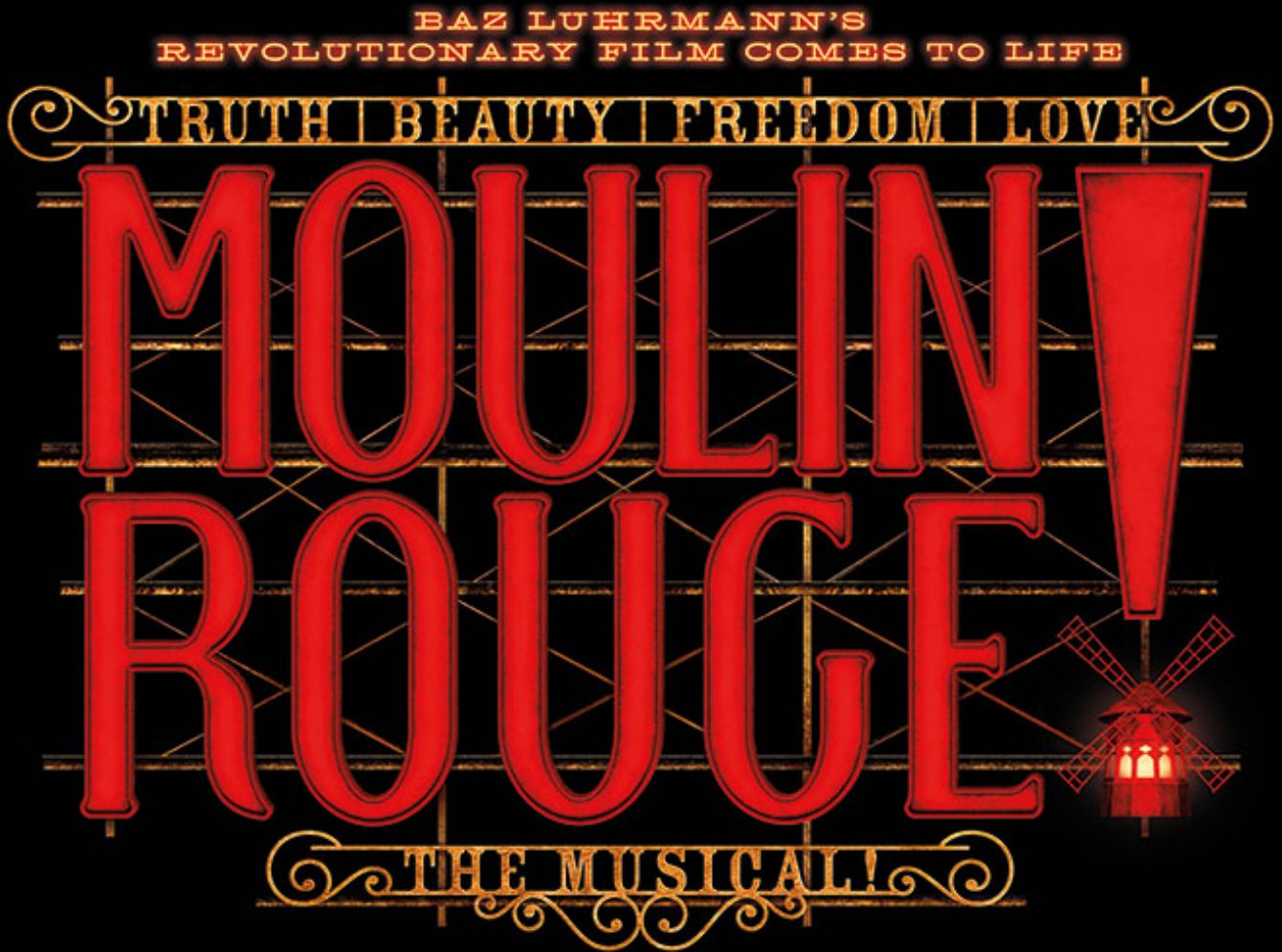


SENSORY GUIDE



GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Note that decibel levels (dB) recorded for this guide include times of applause and sound levels will vary depending on the specific audience
- This performance has high sensory impact and strobing effects
- Note that there are themes that are sexual in nature
- This is a list of possible sensory impacts you may experience while viewing this performance. Part of the magic of live performance is that unexpected things happen, so not every moment can be accounted for.

Common Decibel (dB) Levels

70	Office/classroom chatter
80	Busy traffic, dog barking
90	Hairdryer
100	Lawnmower, construction site
110	Concert, night club
120	Police siren, airplane taking off

- Sudden confetti popper released to the front of the audience
- Bright, flashing lights
- Strobing effects
- Up to 102.5 dB

Street - Sidewalk
Cafe

- Complex sounds
- Up to 98.4 dB



The Club

- Loud, palpable bass
- Abrupt loud sounds
- Bright, flashing lights
- Up to 96.1 dB



Backstage

- Heavy bass
- Bright, flashing/moving lights
- Some lights briefly point towards audience
- Up to 96.5 dB



Inside the
Elephant

- Bright, moving lights
- Complex sounds
- Shouting/shrieking
- Up to 92.4 dB

Street - Sidewalk
Cafe

- Up to 92.7 dB

- Strobing effects
- Whistle sound effects
- Up to 103 dB



Lautrec's Garret

- Up to 93 dB



The Boulevard

- Heavy, palpable bass
- Bright, flashing lights
- Strobing effects
- Up to 94.4 dB



The Club

- Shouting/loud arguing
- Complex noise
- Up to 84.9 dB



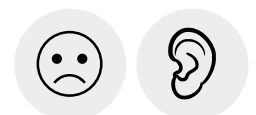
The Garret

- Sudden/abrupt sounds
- Complex noise
- Heavy bass
- Strobing effects
- Bright, flashing/moving lights
- Up to 99.3 dB



The Street/The
Duke's Apartment

- Minor aggression
- Threats of violence
- Heavy bass
- Up to 92.9 dB

Private Backstage Area, Backstage, and Street

- Complex noise
- Shouting/yelling
- Bright, flashing lights
- High emotional intensity
- Up to 98.1 dB

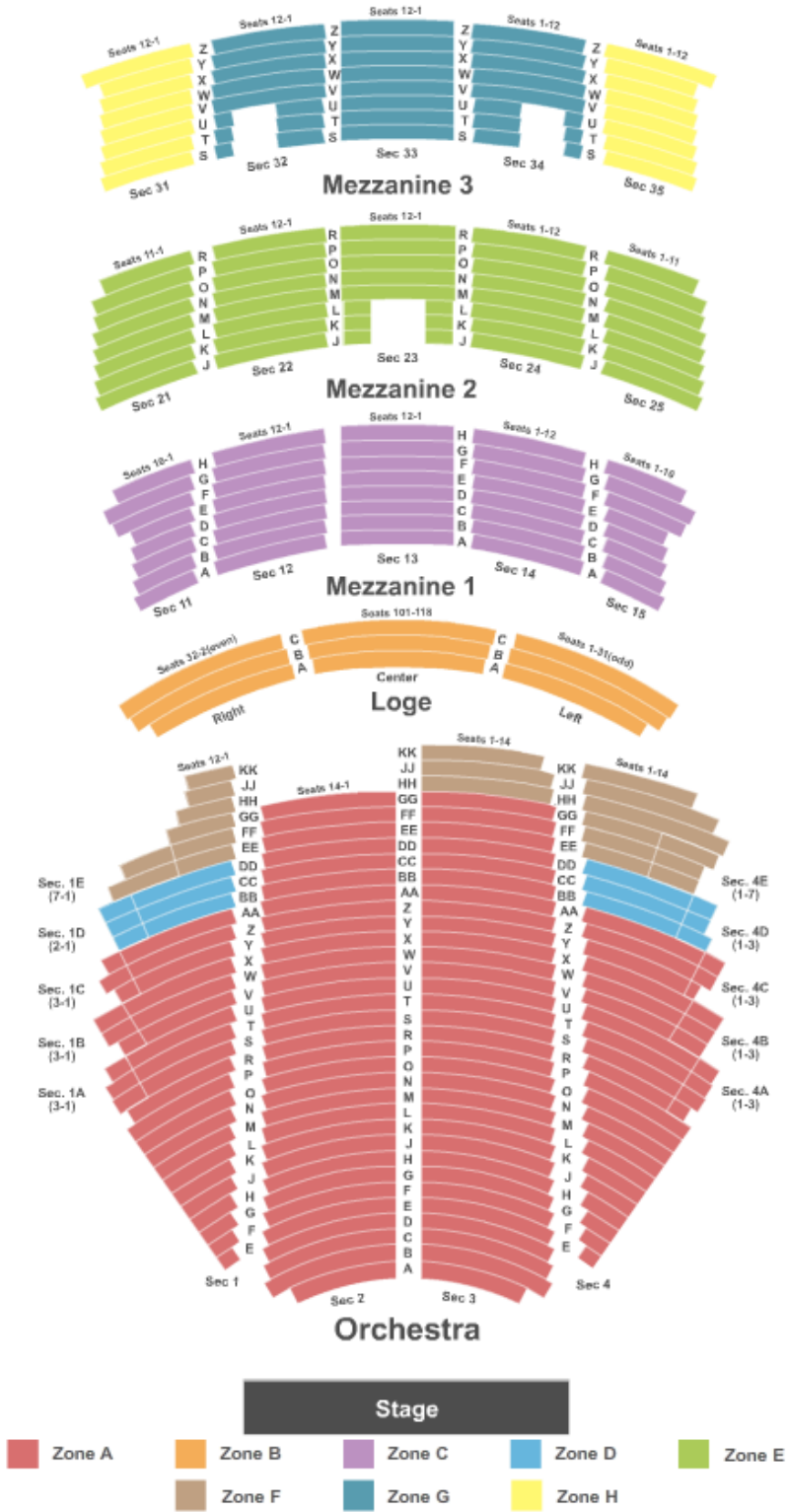


The Club and Backstage

- Brief, sudden blackout
- Complex noise
- Prop gun is pointed towards cast members
- High emotional intensity
- Bell sound effect
- Up to 106.6 dB
