SUMMER IN EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

STG's Education and Community Engagement team produced fabulous renditions of its hallmark summer programming – DANCE This, DANCE This Camp, and AileyCamp. Cumulatively, these programs created space for 174 performers and participants to learn, grow, and share in community, with leadership and mentoring from 14 faculty members and 12 guest artists. Interns, guidance counselors, and group leaders also played an important role in this process, with nearly 1,000 audience members in attendance at AileyCamp's finale share and 1,634 at DANCE This.

It was a beautiful weekend at historic Fort Worden in Port Townsend for this year's THING Festival, where STG welcomed nearly 9,400 guests from August 25 – 27. THING continued to highlight local and national musicians and artists with an emphasis on music discovery, including excellent sets from Fleet Foxes, Lil Yachty, Tash Sultana, Laufey, to name a few. In addition to 52 market booths filled with locally made crafts and goods and the largest number of food vendors yet, the festival had expansive community-focused offerings. 435 participants joined the STG Community Engagement workshops, which ranged from Bollywood Dance, Yoga, and Hip-Hop to Musical Theatre Improv. THING also featured More Music @ The Moore bands Midpak, Cherry Ferrari, and THEM, and performances from ELEVATE participants before daytime sets on the Parade Grounds stage.
